



To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Robert A. May, a citizen of the United States, residing in Wynnewood, county of Montgomery, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Pencil Sharpener, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, which forms a part thereof.
